Endorsements will be considered for all statewide CDP offices and for all Regional Director positions which include one of the Assembly Districts in LA County (CDP Region 10 – 16). Each candidate shall be allotted a set amount of time to present, which may be used by the candidate, a surrogate, or a combination of both. An endorsement vote will be taken by show of cards after speeches have concluded for each office. Members will have the option to vote for any eligible candidate in the race, or the option of No Endorsement. A candidate must receive at least a simple majority among those voting in order to receive the endorsement. Only candidates that are listed by the CDP as of the April 19, 2017, update shall be eligible for consideration.
